
ORDER OF FINAL APPROVAL OF
COUNSEL FEES, COSTS AND
INCENTIVE AWARD

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on August 22, 2018, the return date of the continued hearing on plaintiff's Motion for an Order Granting Final Approval of a Class Action Settlement, Awarding Attorney's Fees and Costs and Granting an Incentive Award to the Plaintiff, in the presence of plaintiff's Class Counsel, Joseph M. Pinto, Esquire, Joseph F. Polino, Esquire and Carl D. Poplar, Esquire, and counsel for the defendants Global Client Solutions, L.L.C. and Rocky Mountain Bank and Trust, GreenspoonMarder, Richard Epstein, Esquire, appearing, and it appearing that the Court previously entered an Order on June 22, 2018 resolving certain issues other than plaintiff's attorney's fees and costs and the plaintiff's incentive payment, and the Court having reviewed all of the Supplemental Declarations, Briefs and other

pleadings submitted at the Court's Request, and the Court having heard the arguments of counsel and considered plaintiff's counsel's voluntary adjustment of the requested fees and the court having confirmed by its own analysis and review of the facts and applicable law that a reasonable adjustment of the fee request is warranted, and the Court having considered the reasonableness of the fee request under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23h and having made its findings of fact and conclusions of law on the record, the Court's oral opinion being incorporated herein, and the Court having approved the reasonableness of the requested costs and incentive award, and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 23rd day of August, 2018, **ORDERED** that:

1. Plaintiff's Class Counsel are awarded an attorney's fee of One Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$1,750,000.00) Dollars, inclusive of costs and a 10 percent Rendine enhancement;
2. Plaintiff is awarded an incentive payment of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars based upon the services rendered to the Class in this action; and
3. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, these fees, costs and incentive award are to be paid by the defendants, within the time period provided by the Settlement Agreement, and not from any funds due to the Class Members under the settlement agreement.
